Cost is \$89 per person and will be paid separately to the tour company. Registration form is attached.

The Grand Canyon via Sedona and the Navajo Reservation tour departs from the hotel between 6:30-7:00 a.m. The guide will provide a narrated tour as we travel through the Sonoran Desert up to the red rock country of Sedona. We make a 1/2 hour stop in Sedona for a coffee break, leg stretch and bathroom stop. The tour continues with a 17-mile drive up scenic Oak Creek Canyon through the mountains of Flagstaff and arrives at the Grand Canyon about 11:30-12:00 noon. Admission to the Canyon is paid for, and the guide will provide an orientation at an overlook at the Grand Canyon village area, and gives the guests approximately 1 ½ hours in the Village area at one of the lodges for a lunch break and time to walk along the rim of the Canyon. After the lunch break the guide will gather everyone and provide a 2 to 3 hour tour along the scenic East rim drive. There's a 23 mile drive along the rim of the Canyon where stops will be made at different viewpoints to get out and learn about the Canyon from the guide. The last stop is everyone's favorite - Desert View Watchtower. About 4:00 pm we depart the Canyon and travel across to the Navajo reservation. A stop will be made at historic Cameron Trading post - a working Navajo Indian trading post. The guide provides information about the Navajo people and guests will have about ½ hour for shopping. A dinner or snack stop will be made in the Camp Verde area on the way back to Scottsdale where you arrive about 8:30 p.m. Please refer to the IGS 2003 website for more information.
